# From the Pastor

July 6, 2008

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Jude,

Last week, I received notification that an Economic Stimulus Tax Rebate check to the tune of about \$300.00 would be on its way to me in the next several weeks. When the checks were first announced, I decided that I would donate mine towards the purchase of new vestments, and then ask parishioners if they would be interested in donating a portion of theirs towards vestments, or sacred vessels, or St. Jude Outreach, or the Capital Campaign, or whatever they want, if they were fortunate enough to be able to do so.

I know many people will immediately apply their check to pay off bills, for gasoline, for next winter's oil – for very basic necessities. That should most definitely be done if that is one's situation. Remember: charity begins at home!

But this past Sunday, Fr. Todd gave me a print-out about other churches promoting similar ideas among their congregations. What do you think of that - they stole my idea! or is it that great minds think alike? or, oh... never mind! Anyhow, it just so happened that the Rosary Altar Society members were selling raffles for their annual summer fundraiser (Friday, July 11) from which all the proceeds go to the beautification of the church sanctuary. The timing was right for me to put this thought out to you.

In the last few months, we have purchased new altar cloth material, and a Rosarian member has been working on the new cloths. They will be in all the liturgical seasonal colors. I'm sure you noticed the beautiful red-trimmed one this past Sunday for Ss. Peter and Paul, and by the time you are reading this, the green one (she hopes) will be completed and on the altar. This material was purchased through funds raised by the Rosarians for just such purposes.

I would like St. Jude to have vestment sets in all the liturgical colors: chasubles for the priests, dalmatics for the deacons; copes for special Masses, Benediction and marriages, so that every one is coordinated. We are also in need of new ciboria (the vessels in which the Eucharist is kept) and chalices. It certainly dignifies the celebration of the Holy sacrifice when we have beautiful things for the worship of God. He deserves it, and so do we.

I will be donating to the parish three of the chasuble, stole, and chalice veil sets which I have personally purchased in the last couple of years: one gold, one white, one rose – and eventually get the deacons' vestments to match. They are not the very 'top of the line' that cost thousands each, but they are very good quality, costing (on average) less than \$500.00 each. Maybe we will be able to get a quantity discount.

I hope to make available in the near future a list of what is needed, with prices, for anyone who might want to memorialize a single item or perhaps a set. Please call the office or speak to me if you have any questions about this.
