## Thank-Yous & Current Events, April 2016

Two weeks ago the Church celebrated the glorious Resurrection from the dead of our blessed Lord. We continue to celebrate through to the great Feast of the Holy Spirit – Pentecost. I extend thanks to all those who gave of themselves during the Lenten Season observances and Holy Week celebrations.

Our annual **Lenten Friday Fish Fry** was, as always, enjoyable and successful. Thanks to those members of both the Shrine of St. Jude Council and the J.V. Kavanaugh Knights of Columbus who shopped, fried, cooked, swept and manned ticket table and kitchen. Likewise, the Rosarians were always on hand to serve, make desserts and clean up – and try to keep the men in good order! Thanks also to all of the other parish ministries who participated. The parish netted \$4,254 for the effort.

Members of the Shrine Knights of Columbus planted daffodil and hyacinth bulbs back in the fall; and more recently they cleaned up the flower beds, mulched and put new flowers in the planters to prepare for Easter and spring; mostly at the church, but also at the parish center and the rectory. Thanks for beautifying our parish grounds!

Following the final Fish Fry on March 18th, **the St. Jude Youth Group** did a great job in presenting a silhouetted **Way of the Cross** on the stage in the parish center. The presentation was different and very moving, as all of the action took place behind two large white screens. The young people also presented it twice the following week for the evening Faith Formation classes. I look forward to this presentation next Lent. Thanks to all those youths (and assisting adults) who did such a heart-felt job of helping us experience the Stations of our Lord's Cross.

On Palm Sunday, the Children's Choir did a beautiful job in the entrance procession at the 9:30 Mass, singing, "The Children of Jerusalem," who welcomed our blessed Lord at his triumphant entrance into the Holy City. We look forward to them continuing to grow in their repertoire and helping to enhance our liturgical prayer.

Additional thanks to our Music Ministry and Adult Choir for all of the music on Palm Sunday, and throughout the Holy Week Sacred Triduum Liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday Masses; for their prayerful singing and instrumental work. Our Altar Servers practiced and served well, doing admirably with the all of the annual ceremonies. Thanks to all those who beautifully arranged the Easter flowers; also our church cleaners, whose job is thankless and never ends. And for the members of our *Rite of Christian Initiation* (R.C.I.A.) team and Faith Formation catechists who prepared the adults and young people for baptism, confirmation, and reception of the Most Holy Eucharist on Holy Saturday. May our parish and Church continue to grow in numbers, and most especially in the Holy Spirit!

Though I have not yet made an official request from the pulpit, the **2016 Catholic Ministries Appeal (CMA)** is going well. Thus far 135 donors have made \$51,347 in pledges towards our parish goal of \$61,900. Thanks to those who have thus far participated, and hopefully we will reach our goal in the next few weeks. Please consider a gift to the CMA, even if it is \$100 or \$25, every gift helps the work of our diocese in Catholic education and charities, and a portion is rebated to the parish for our own needs.

Thanks to you, the **Capital Campaign is also doing well**. To date we have received 375 gifts/pledges totaling \$1,302,288 towards our challenge goal of \$1.5 million. This is a tribute to your support of the good things we have planned for the new Shrine-Chapel, Lourdes Grotto, and Rosary walk, among a number of other necessary projects to update our parish infrastructure, and to beautify and enhance the overall appearance of our buildings and grounds. We are still awaiting other proposals on the asbestos testing and abatement that needs to be done before the old rectory and old church can be razed. These aspects of the process that take time, and must be done properly and to code.

Lastly, the man from Durhan Studios who made and installed the **stained glass in the church** gave me a call, asking if he could come out and give me a proposal for completing the glass in the church, knowing that it is on our "wish list." I was very happy to meet with him, and he will be getting back to me with some designs and a project cost proposal. Just picture our beautiful church with the stained glass complete! Through the intercession of St. Jude and the generosity of our generous parishioners and benefactors, this will most certainly happen.

On Saturday, September 24, Bishop Murphy will be leading a **Diocesan Year of Mercy Pilgrimage** to the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington D.C. **If you are interested, please contact the rectory this week.** If there is sufficient interest, we will look into hiring a bus; if there is little interest, we may then direct individuals to team up with another parish in obtaining transportation.
