## Important Lenten Information

**SCHEDULE FOR ASH WEDNESDAY:** Ashes will be distributed during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on March 1st, Ash Wednesday, at 9AM, 12 noon, and 7:30PM. In addition to these Masses, ashes will be distributed during prayer service at 7:30AM, 4PM and at 5PM.

**LENTEN REGULATIONS:** All Catholics who reached their fourteenth year are bound to abstain entirely from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Friday's of Lent. All Catholics between the ages of eighteen and fifty-nine inclusive are also bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food in between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be eaten during the day.

**LENTEN STATIONS OF THE CROSS:** The Way of the Cross each Friday evening during Lent at 7:30PM. Spanish Stations will be on Tuesday at 7:30PM.

**SACRAMENT OF CONFESSION/PENANCE:** Lent is a special time of Grace in the life of the Church. It is time when many people receive the Grace to come back to the practice of the faith. It is also time of ongoing conversion for each of us. Sacrament of Confession/Penance is available each Saturday during Lent 3:30PM-4:45PM and on Wednesday 2PM- 2:45PM. We encourage you to make use of this sacrament. The Confession schedule for Holy Week will be printed closer to that week. Please mention this opportunity to family and friends who may be looking for the opportunity to "come home"!

**MORNING LAUDS:** As has been the custom here at St. Jude, we pray the Morning Prayer FROM THE LITURGY OF THE HOURS (The prayer of the Church) Monday through Friday at 8:15 AM, followed by the Holy Rosary.

## CATHOLIC MINISTRIES APPEAL

The 'Catholic Ministries Appeal' has begun in our Parish and across the Diocese. The 'Catholic Ministries Appeal' is the yearly appeal that helps our diocese fund many ministries, services and agencies in the 133 parishes across Long Island. 
The parish attained 107.56% of our 2016 CMA Goal of \$61,900. The parish share received \$15,872. Thank you for your generous support of last year's CMA.

## Letter from Fr. Ryan

This week, beginning Ash Wednesday, the Church enters into the extraordinary season of Lent. Lent is a time of conversion and renewal for all of us. As we enter these days of Lent, may we open our hearts to the graces of God and allow him to work in our lives and truly experience his gifts of mercy, forgiveness, blessings and every benefit of his love.

Lent is a time of fasting, prayer and almsgiving. It is a time of penance. I don't think we need to fast from chocolate and cookies as much as we need to fast from the things that may have taken hold of the depths of our whole inner being like anger, selfishness, impatience, laziness, judgement, and those particular things that every individual knows best for himself or herself that needs the fast. Lent is the season to start the change, the conversion.

Our personal prayers. Praying to God with gratitude for the gift of life, his Son, his Church, our faith, family, and every blessing under the heavens. Praying more means giving God more time during this time of conversion. And almsgiving is more about others than myself. Dear Friends:

For those of us who need an extension, let's give ourselves till Easter Sunday, April 16, 2017 to make that compassionate invitation to our friends. And let's open ourselves to making these invitations more frequently and consistently. When we die, we will all look lovingly into the merciful eyes of Jesus and review our life with him. The people whom we have helped to invite back to Mass and their Catholic faith will be standing around us with radiant smiles. And we want a big crowd!

We connect our Lenten 2017 prayer, fasting and almsgiving together to this intention and to our constant intention to pray for our brothers and sisters who are poor, hungry, suffering from war, violence or persecution in our world.

You and your families are all daily in my prayers and Masses. Thank you for your witness of "holiness and mission" to the world.
